Push factors encourage people to leave a place.
Pull factors attract people to a place.

PUSH FACTORS

Reasons people leave a place.



Few jobs or low wages



Poor living conditions



Conflict, violence or war



Natural disasters or environmental problems



Limited access to education or healthcare



PULL FACTORS

Reasons people move to a place.



Jobs or better wages



Better living conditions



Safety and security



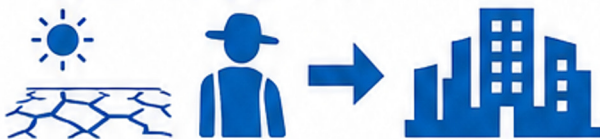
Good climate and natural environment



Access to education and healthcare

EXAMPLES

Push: Drought destroys crops. Farmers leave the area.



Pull: A city offers jobs, good schools and healthcare. People move there.
