RESILIENCE



The ability to recover from challenges and keep going.

Example: The story shows resilience in tough times.

FRIENDSHIP



A close bond between people based on trust and support.

Example: Friendship is a central theme in the novel.

COURAGE



The ability to face fear, danger, or difficulty.

Example: The character shows great courage.

IDENTITY



A sense of who you are as an individual.

Example: The theme of identity shapes the plot.

BELONGING



Feeling accepted and valued as part of a group or community.

Example: The story explores the need for belonging.

JUSTICE



Fairness and the treatment of people in a just way.

Example: The theme of justice drives the conflict.

LOVE



A strong feeling of care, affection, or devotion.

Example: Love is a powerful theme in many stories.

BETRAYAL



Breaking trust or disloyalty to someone.

Example: Betrayal changes the course of the story.

POWER



The ability to influence people or events.

Example: The misuse of power is a key theme.

FREEDOM



The state of being free or having choices.

Example: Freedom is a desired theme for many characters.

SACRIFICE



Giving up something important for the good of others.

Example: Sacrifice is a powerful act of love.

HOPE



A feeling of optimism for the future.

Example: Hope keeps the characters going.
