

CONFLICT RESOLUTION

ROLE-PLAY CARDS



Pick a card. Read the situation. Role-play both roles.
Work together to find a solution.



1. THE SHARED PENCIL

SITUATION:

You both want to use the only pencil left in the box.

YOU ARE: Student A

OTHER PERSON: Student B

GOAL: Take turns and find a fair solution.



2. GAME TIME

SITUATION:

You are having a game and someone keeps changing the rules.

YOU ARE: Player 1

OTHER PERSON: Player 2

GOAL: Agree on rules everyone is happy with.



3. LEFT OUT

SITUATION:

You see others playing together and didn't ask you to join.

YOU ARE: The person who feels left out

OTHER PERSON: Someone in the group

GOAL: Include everyone and be respectful.



4. BORROWED WITHOUT ASKING

SITUATION:

Someone used your book or item without asking first.

YOU ARE: The owner of the item

OTHER PERSON: The person who used it

GOAL: Apologise and agree on what to do next.



5. UNKIND WORDS

SITUATION:

You said something unkind. The other person is upset.

YOU ARE: The person who said it

OTHER PERSON: The person who was hurt

GOAL: Apologise and make things right.



6. INTERRUPTED

SITUATION:

You were talking and someone kept interrupting you.

YOU ARE: The person who was talking

OTHER PERSON: The person who interrupted

GOAL: Listen and take turns to speak.



7. SPACE PROBLEM

SITUATION:

You both want the same seat or spot.

YOU ARE: Student A

OTHER PERSON: Student B

GOAL: Share the space or find a new solution.



8. DIFFERENT IDEAS

SITUATION:

You are working on a group task but you disagree on what to do.

YOU ARE: Idea 1

OTHER PERSON: Idea 2

GOAL: Combine ideas and make a plan.



9. NOT FAIR?

SITUATION:

You think the task or jobs were not shared equally.

YOU ARE: The person who thinks it's not fair

OTHER PERSON: The person who gave out the jobs

GOAL: Talk it through and make it fair for everyone.
