

Animal Adaptations Label Cards



Thick Fur

Keeps animals warm in cold environments.



Blubber

Insulates and stores energy in cold water.



Water Storage

Stores water to survive in hot, dry places.



Water Conservation

Helps animals reduce water loss.



Hump

Stores fat for energy when food is scarce.



Large Ears

Help release heat and cool the body.



Webbed Feet

Help animals swim and move in water.



Specialised Beak

Designed for a specific food or task.



Camouflage

Helps animals blend in and avoid predators.



White Colour

Helps animals blend in with snow and ice.



Gills

Allow animals to extract oxygen from water.



Speed

Helps animals escape from predators.



Claws

Help animals catch prey, climb, or dig.



Feathers

Provide warmth, waterproofing, and help with flight.



Hard Shell

Protects animals from predators and injury.



Long Neck

Helps animals reach food high up in trees.



Night Vision

Helps animals see in low-light conditions.



Migration

Helps animals find food and better climates.
