1 Mammals



- Have hair or fur.
- Mothers feed babies milk.
- Warm-blooded.

2 Birds



- Have feathers.
- Lay hard-shelled eggs.
- Have wings and beaks.

3 Reptiles



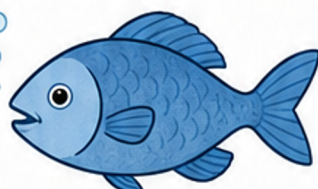
- Have dry, scaly skin.
- Lay eggs on land.
- Cold-blooded.

4 Amphibians



- Live on land and in water.
- Lay jelly-like eggs in water.
- Moist, smooth skin.

5 Fish



- Live in water.
- Breathe using gills.
- Have fins and scales.

6 Insects



- Have 6 legs.
- Many have wings.
- Body in 3 parts: head, thorax, abdomen.

7 Arachnids



- Have 8 legs.
- Body in 2 parts.
- Not insects.

8 Crustaceans



- Have hard shells.
- Breathe using gills.
- Many have 10 legs.

9 Molluscs



- Many have shells.
- Soft body.
- Examples: snails, slugs, mussels.

10 Echinoderms



- Spiny skin.
- Usually 5 arms.
- Live in the sea.

11 Cnidarians



- Have stinging cells.
- Soft, jelly-like body.
- Mostly live in water.

12 Poriferans



- Pores let water flow through.
- Filter food from water.
- Usually stay in one place.
