## E EFFECT

Explore the effect or significance.

## L LINK (CONCLUSION)

Conclude the paragraph by linking back and looking forward.

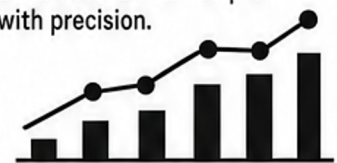
