Events like floods, droughts or earthquakes.

## POVERTY

Not enough money for basic needs like food or shelter.

## LACK OF EDUCATION

Few or no schools or training opportunities.

## DISCRIMINATION OR PERSECUTION

Unfair treatment because of race, religion or beliefs.

## POOR HEALTH CARE

Limited access to doctors or medical care.



**PUSH**

## OVERCROWDING

Too many people and not enough resources.



**PULL**

## BETTER JOB OPPORTUNITIES

More jobs and higher pay.



**PULL**

## SAFETY AND PEACE

A safe place with less violence or conflict.



**PULL**

## HIGHER LIVING STANDARDS

Better homes, food, clothing and services.



**PULL**

## QUALITY EDUCATION

Good schools and more learning opportunities.



**PULL**

## GOOD HEALTH CARE

Access to hospitals, doctors and medicine.

## FAMILY REUNION

Joining family members who already live there.

## POLITICAL FREEDOM

Freedom to speak, practice religion and vote.
